Present simple tense (states with states verbs)

Wants & likes	Like, dislike, love, hate, prefer, need, want, wish
Thought & opinion	Think, remember, forget, know, believe, imagine
Senses	See , hear , smell, taste , feel
Appearance	Seem, look, look like, appear, resemble, sound
Possession & relation	Have, own, belong, possess
Other state verbs	Cost , depend ,include , involve ,contain

Since these verbs are state verbs, it's very important to remember that we don't use —ing forms with these.

Exercise: In the following sentence, make corrections where necessary.

- 1-I have two brothers. (Correct /state verb)
- 2-Tanya works as a nurse in a hospital. (Correct /permanent situation)
- 3-I'm always getting up at 7.... (wrong /I always get up at 7)/ Habit /routine
- 4-Can you be quiet, please? We read. (Wrong / we are reading / it's happening now so we use present continuous).
- 5-Jason is very busy today .He's working on an important report. (Correct /because this is a temporary situation not a permanent situation)
- 6-I'm not understanding what you are saying. (Wrong /I don't understand. because understand is a state verb .it's a verb express mental state.)
- 7-Do you think it rains outside? (Wrong /because the question is about something happening now, at this moment. Do you think it's raining outside?
- 8-Ali eats out once a week. (Correct / habit /routine)
- 9-My grandparents are living in India. (Wrong /my grandparents live in India)
- 10-The word huge is meaning very big. (Wrong /the word huge means very big) because this is a fact, so you can't use the continuous form here.
